1**Hang tight****What's happening**

- Your healthcare provider has sent your prescription to either AllianceRx or Orsini Specialty Pharmacy
- The pharmacy coordinators will check with your insurance company to determine your coverage eligibility for VYEPTI
- Over the next several weeks, the pharmacy, your healthcare provider, and your insurance company will coordinate efforts for you to receive VYEPTI

What you need to do

- Work with your healthcare provider to decide where you will receive your infusion
- Note the address for when the pharmacy coordinator calls

2**Answer the call****What's happening**

- A coordinator from either Orsini Specialty Pharmacy or AllianceRx will call you to confirm the shipping address and process your copayment for VYEPTI
- The call may come from an unknown or unfamiliar number
- Don't worry if the first call is missed—the coordinator will make several more attempts and will leave a voice message with call-back instructions

What you need to do

- Answer the specialty pharmacy's call or call them back to avoid delays in your VYEPTI treatment
- Provide a payment method and the shipping address for your infusion location to complete your order
- If eligible, provide the specialty pharmacy with your VYEPTI Copay Assistance information

Helpful tip

Be sure your voicemail box isn't full!

3**Schedule your appointment****What's happening**

- After confirming the infusion location's shipping address with you, the specialty pharmacy will ship VYEPTI to the infusion location to arrive on the agreed-upon date
- The doctor's office / infusion location will also call you to schedule your infusion appointment

What you need to do

- Expect a call from the doctor's office / infusion location
- You can also call the office directly to set up your infusion appointment

VYEPTI is a prescription medicine used for the preventive treatment of migraine in adults.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Do not receive VYEPTI if you have a known allergy to eptinezumab-jjmr or its ingredients.

VYEPTI may cause allergic reactions. Call your healthcare provider or get emergency medical help right away if you have any symptoms of an allergic reaction: rash, swelling of your face, lips, tongue, or throat, if you have trouble breathing, hives or redness in your face.

Before starting VYEPTI, tell your healthcare provider about all your medical conditions, including if you are pregnant or plan to become pregnant, or you are breastfeeding or plan to breastfeed.

Tell your healthcare provider about all the medicines you take, including any prescription and over-the-counter medicines, vitamins, or herbal supplements

The most common side effects of VYEPTI include stuffy nose and scratchy throat, and allergic reactions.

These are not all the possible side effects of VYEPTI. Tell your healthcare provider if you have any side effect that bothers you or that does not go away.
